Randall Library Building Committee
September 27, 2012

Meeting called to order at 7:19 p.m.

Jim Salvie gave an update on the various articles of the Warrant scheduled to come to the town. He believes that all three articles should go to the town at the same time, which is also the consensus of the Selectmen.

The report essentially related how the Community Center Committee has some serious disagreement on which of the two proposals they have narrowed to and will probably present both to the town.

Costs of all three (four) projects will appear in the articles. Library will be \$3.7 total, with the commitment of the Library plus anticipated funds from the CPA to bring down the cost to \$3.2 Million. This brings the total cost to each Stow household of \$75.00 over 20 years figured at 4% rate.

If all three projects were approved (excluding the School Committee proposal), the cost to each household would be \$425.00 for 20 years.
