

STOW RECREATION DEPARTMENT COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM

The Stow Recreation Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program is designed for campers who turn 13 by July 1, 2015, and who are interested in becoming better leaders. The CIT Program will be offered at our Half & Full Day Summer Camp Program. This program covers a curriculum that includes such topics as leadership, conflict resolution, child development and group dynamics that leads to the making of a successful Camp Counselor, and a better leader. CITs will be evaluated by the Camp Staff at the end of their session. Successful completion of the program and positive evaluations could lead to the participant being invited back the following season to interview for a staff position (must be sixteen to be considered.) Because of the small number of spaces available and the highly competitive nature of this program, all potential applicants must complete a CIT Application in order to determine suitability for the program.
