Vote on Election Day, November 8th

Registered voters may vote Absentee if he/she (1) will be **absent** from your city or town on Election Day, And/or (2) have a **physical disability** that prevents you from voting at the polling place, and/or (3) cannot vote at the polls due to **religious beliefs**.

Submit an [Absentee Ballot Application](#) to the Town Clerk's Office. * **There are 2 applications available – one if you are completing the application for yourself and one if you are completing the application for a family member that lives in your home.** *

The voter may vote the ballot at the Clerk's office OR have a ballot mailed to him/her.

Voting in Person Process: Voters check in, fill out a ballot envelope, vote & seal their ballot in the envelope, place envelope in ballot box. Ballots are cast at polls on Nov. 8th just as if the voter was there in person.

Vote Early by Mail Process: Voter fills out [Early Voting Application](#), ballot is mailed to the voter, and voter returns completed ballot (in a special early voting envelope) to the Town Clerk. Ballots will be cast at the polls on November 8th just as if the voter was there in person.
