

Town Administrator's Report

Town of Stow, MA - 2016-01-05 Selectmen's Minutes

Mr. Wrigley informed the Board that the Town has recently received notice from the State Department of Energy Resources that it has been designated a Green Community. Concurrent with this designation is the tentative grant award of \$144,115. For the Town to receive the targeted money, an application identifying the proposed energy improvements to be undertaken must be submitted to the Department of Energy Resources by January 22, 2016.

He mentioned that MassDOT had notified the Town that they expect to reduce the Gleasondale Bridge to one way traffic on January 9th and that the traffic signal is complete. The bridge will be completely closed on the morning of the 9th allowing for the installation of the jersey barriers but will reopen in the afternoon.
