

**Minutes
Board of Selectmen Meeting
Executive Session
Pompo Community Center
February 25, 2020**

Physically present at this meeting at the Pompo Community Center were James Salvie, Brian Burke, Cortni Frecha and Thomas Ryan. Also present were Doug Hyde, Assistant Facilities Manager, Steve Jelinek of Capital Planning Committee and Kathy Sferra of the Conservation Department.

Also present physically were Town Administrator William Wrigley, and Executive Assistant Maureen McKeon.

There was a brief discussion regarding Town groups/departments that might be interested in acquiring the Blue Door church located on Great Road. It was agreed that those interested should gather further information regarding the property. Mr. Jelinek stated that it was his opinion that it was not wise to spend money at this time.

Mr. Ryan moved to authorize Kathy Sferra to take up the conversation with the church about protecting the interest of the adjacent park and easement and "float" a soft offer of \$300,000 for the property and gauge the reaction by the property owner. Ms. Frecha seconded the motion and it was passed 3:0:1. Ms. Frecha, aye, Mr. Salvie, aye, and Mr. Ryan, aye. Mr. Burke, abstained.
