 - Resume of projects, especially all previous work with renovation and prefab or alternate construction methods
 - Reference from a minimum of five (5) previous projects involving the construction of similar public buildings including previous work with renovation and prefab or alternate construction methods if possible.
 - o Resume of Project Director, including references.
 - o Proof of MCPPO certification by the Inspector General's office
 - o List of all consultants and description of their qualifications.

Any additional supporting material requested in the Evaluation Criteria section

We will be holding an information session on Thursday, October 9 at 10:00am at the Stow Town Building, 380 Great Road, Stow. A tour of the current elementary school buildings will follow a brief presentation. Both meetings are optional.
