Questions and Answers

Q. You submitted statement of interest in 2007, have you had the two tours by MSBA. What was the tone of those?

A. *Yes, tours have been completed. The statement of interest was pretty clear on the need, we have been caught up on the state regionalization, we spend a lot of time explaining to them we are a Region and are not interest in taking in another town. We are now on the feasibility list, MSBA seems to be supportive for going forward.*

Q. Have you had ongoing discussions on enroll projections?

A. *We have just completed our Oct. 2008 enrollment numbers are they are inline with our projections. There are a number of building projects on the horizon in Stow and they are selling.*

Q. Did you have your building committee approved?

A. *Yes.*

Q. Who is your MSBA coordinator?

A. *Amy Lanning,*

Q. What is your time frame to break ground?

A. *In Fall of 2009.*

Q. What was the last override Stow did? How did it go?

A. *This project, 75% approval at polls.*

Q. You are thinking you will build a new space and use it as a swing space during construction?

A. *No we would use space at the Pompositticut School. (Mr. Wood displayed on diagram how the space issue would be resolved during building).*

Q. How far has the project draft gone?

A. *Concept only.*

Q. Have you reviewed the draft feasibility?

A. *Yes.*

Q. What will you do with the Pompositticut School after project completion?

A. *The school will be turned back to the Town, as they own the building. Once turned back it will be theirs to manage.*

Q. Would renovations during building project be needed at the Pompositticut School?

A. *No.*
