Standards

The Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties:

Rehabilitation

A new addition must preserve the building's historic character, form, significant materials, and features. It must be compatible with the massing, size, scale, and design of the historic <u>building</u> while <u>differentiated from the historic building</u>. It should also be designed and constructed so that the essential form and integrity of the historic building would remain if the addition were to be removed in the future.


