Re: Lower Village Business District Bylaw Working Session

The purpose of tonight's working session is to review feedback on the content of the draft Lower Village Business District bylaw and review a revised draft presentation for upcoming meetings. The following items have been raised by Board members, staff, or residents:

1. Landscaped Buffers to Residences

The proposed bylaw decreases the existing requirement of a 50 foot landscaped buffer between Business District parcels and Residential District or Recreation-Conservation District parcels. This is described in the existing Zoning Bylaw in Section 4.4 (1). The proposed bylaw Section 3.3.5.17 reduces this to 30 feet. Neither the existing bylaw nor the proposed bylaw include strict requirements of landscaped buffers to residences within the Business District. However, this may be requested during the Special Permit and/or Site Plan Approval process as it is currently. The rationale for reducing the setback is to allow site designs to be flexible as each parcel in Lower Village has a unique set of considerations. The Planning Board may request wider buffers and additional landscaping on a case by case basis.

2. Exterior Lighting Standards

Section 3.3.5.11 of the draft bylaw describes exterior lighting standards, which have not yet been discussed by the Board.
