Alcoholic Beverages Policy

The Trustees of the Randall Library encourage community groups and Stow residents to hold events in the Library's common spaces both during regular operating hours and at times when the Library normally is not open. Certain fees and safety, security and property protection restrictions may apply, including restrictions on alcoholic beverages.

- 1. No alcoholic beverages may be served or consumed in the Library during regular operating hours.
- 2. Trustees, as a town organization, may sponsor events in which alcohol is served.
- 3. Events sponsored or managed by an outside group (other than the Trustees) that involves consumption of alcohol are allowed, with approval of the Board of Trustees, but the sponsoring group must provide adequate liability insurance naming the Town as additionally insured.
- 4. Permission from the Select Board is required to permit alcoholic beverages at events held at the Library at any time. A member of the requesting organization must apply for permission in writing and agree to follow Library procedures. The Select Board will consider each event individually. Included in the request to the Selectmen will be the date, the start and ending hours of the events and what will be served.
- 5. Alcoholic beverages will not be sold at the Library for any reason
