

The Designer, Kaestle Boos Association, Inc. (KBA), and the owner's project manager, Skanska USA Building, Inc., continue to work with the District to progress the Schematic Design.

Recent activities include: site and building design development, geotechnical analysis, site permitting review with Town of Bolton, geothermal feasibility study, and maximizing Mass Save Rebates strategies.



#### Non-Permissible:

- Mass mailings using public funds or resources
- · Distribution via student backpacks
- Use of a school district's ROBOcall system
- Dissemination of information via a school newsletter
- Direct or indirect solicitation or acceptance of fundraising for political purposes including ballot questions
