Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §20, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitations on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Stow Board of Selectmen is being conducted without in person attendance of members of the public. This meeting is being televised by Stow TV, which according to Town Counsel provides the "adequate alternative access" to the public compliant with the Open Meeting Law as modified by the Governor's Order. For this meeting, members of the public who wish to listen/watch may do so in the following manner: Go to the Zoom website on your phone/computer/laptop/tablet. You do not need to download software. Find access code at the top of this agenda, and join before or during the meeting with access code. The Board of Selectmen will have posted a record of the proceedings of this meeting on the Town's web site, if not the video recording of the same, as soon as possible.

Pursuant to G.L. c.30A, s.20(b), the Board of Selectmen believe that the matter identified on the Agenda constitutes an "emergency" and as such, this notice does not comply with the requirement that a public body post notice of every meeting at least 48 hours prior to the meeting. Rather, this notice is being provided as soon as reasonably possible prior to the meeting.
