HOW TO TRANSPORT SAFELY

- Tighten caps and lids.
- Pack in sturdy upright boxes.
- Never smoke while handling hazardous items
- Waste not listed check for acceptability



- Construction Materials
- Fire Extinguishers
- Needles / Syringes get container & return to Nashoba BOH 978-772-3335
- Propane tanks
- Radioactive Waste
- Tires / PCB's

- Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
