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# Addendum #1

## IFB B01-2023 On Call HVAC System Maintenance and Repairs

In response to questions raised during the pre-bid walk through of Stow Town Buildings on Wednesday April 12<sup>th</sup>;

- -The Town Buildings are supplied with well water.
- -There is natural gas at all Town Buildings except for the old Town Hall where the natural gas has been removed.
- -Pompositticut Community Center is certified as being Asbestos Free and there is no asbestos pipe in Town Building, Library, or Police Station to the best of our knowledge.
- -Filter changes at Town Building and Pompositticut Community Center will be taken care of by the facilities department of the town, all other filter changes will be the responsibility of the contractor.
- -Clarification on prevailing wage, the rates submitted on the bid forms should be compliant with prevailing wage law. DLS sent the following response in regard to when the prevailing wage rates will apply, "Section 27D of the prevailing wage law (Construction), will include things like: new construction of a building and/or site, site infrastructure work, surveying, repair, alterations, improvements to a building or site. Installation of building components affixed to a building and/or site, removed from a building and/or site, repaired or replaced. Building and/or site energy management systems, HVAC systems, plumbing, electrical, hot water systems, communication systems, asbestos removal, painting, etc.., these would be defined as construction."

There may be instances where prevailing wage will not apply, and a lower wage will be allowed but for the purposes of consistency in bidding please use the rate that will comply with prevailing wage rates as attached to the Invitation for Bids.

-An equipment list for all the HVAC systems at the Town Buildings is attached. The library will be under renovation in the near future so any changes to equipment and services will be made as they are decided.
