## **Special Rules for Annual Town Meeting 2020**

Town Meeting will be held Saturday, July 11, 2020 at Center School in the cafeteria and in the field behind Center School for anyone who would like additional spacing.

The Moderator has established the following special rules which will be the safety of all. Those who do not follow these rules are subject to removal from the meeting:

- 1. No one who is currently sick, has been sick, or has been exposed to active Covid-19 in the last 14 days shall be allowed in the meeting.
- 2. Social distancing must be maintained while in line to check in at least 6 feet between people.
- 3. Everyone must wear a face covering over the mouth and nose, both inside the school and in the shared tent outdoors (except for children 2 and under).
- 4. Socially distant seating: if chairs are set up in advance, they can only be moved with permission of a Moderator or Town Clerk.
- 5. Only people who live together can sit together.
- 6. Both indoor and outdoor locations will have mics, speakers, and a Moderator. The outside venue will have chairs, although voters may bring more comfortable portable chairs from home.
- 7. If you set up outdoor chairs, you shall keep them at appropriate distances from others (at least 6 feet).
- 8. All marked walking lanes inside and outside shall be kept free of chairs or other obstructions.
- 9. Presentations are limited to a maximum of 10 minutes and must be approved in advance by the Moderator.
- 10. The Moderator will limit speakers to two minutes, and voters may address the meeting once per motion.
- 11. Speakers will stand in lines for microphones as in prior town meetings. Voters waiting to speak will keep appropriate social distancing and will not touch the microphones.
- 12. If special accommodations are needed because of these rules or other reasons, you must contact the Town Clerk by 4:30PM July 2.
