The Town Social Worker provides comprehensive professional social services to assist Stow town residents with social, emotional, and economic needs.

Services include case management, consultation, information and referral, advocacy and support, and crisis intervention. Services are confidential and open to town residents of all ages and income.

The Town Social Worker accepts referrals from various sources including community residents, schools, the police and fire department, clergy, doctors, hospitals, and mental health agencies.

The Town Social Worker can work in collaboration with other community agencies and can meet with clients in the office or the home setting.
